FIFTH TRANSNATIONAL MEETING

The 5th transnational project meeting took place on 10th and 11th September 2019 in Berlin. The host of this final meeting was the leading partner Lehrbauhof | Berlin.

The focus is on the necessary activities for a high-quality project completion and the topics dissemination, sustainability and practical use of the project results.

The finished e-book was successfully presented and revised in details.

During a tour through the training areas of the Lehrbauhof, the European partners met with trainers and apprentices and talked with them about the benefits of the project ModuSOL.

NATIONAL WORKSHOPS & MULTIPLIER-EVENTS

The organization of national learning activities, in which the project participants (teachers and lecturers) pass on their acquired knowledge to their learners, is completed in high quality by all project partners and was finally evaluated during the project meeting. The results achieved met with great interest and showed the readiness of the practical use in the learning processes.



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FINAL CONFERENCE IN BERLIN



The final conference in Berlin on the 11th of September 2019, brought together more than 40 Multipliers and Stakeholders from (vocational) education, labour, academy and interested parties from different social fields to give a compact overview of the work and the results of ModuSOL.



The managing director of the BFW, Mrs. Witschaß, welcomed the participants. Apprentices, whose self-produced learning sequences became part of the eBook, also took part. All European partners summarized their project experiences in brief statements and emphasized the extremely constructive and helpful work of project coordination.



EBOOK

At the final conference, the main result of ModuSOL, a free e-book created by the partners during the two-year collaboration, was presented.

Dr. Bernd Flossmann presented the multilingual eBook in various formats.

The eBook summarizes the analysis of the current situation in each partner country, the didactic-methodological concepts and curriculum to support the development of trainers' competences through best practices, case studies, trainee learning scenarios and an instructor handbook.

In addition, the e-book contains reports on transnational and national learning activities as well as an evaluation of project implementation.

Furthermore some of the videos, which were produced by the partnership and became part of the eBook were presented to the audience.
